Travelling to Sheffield from UK airports

From Manchester Airport to Sheffield

There is a direct train from Manchester Airport to Sheffield, leaving every hour (journey time approximately one hour fifteen minutes).

From London Heathrow to Sheffield

Take the Piccadilly Line to Kings Cross/St Pancras. This takes about an hour. (You can knock 20 minutes off the journey time by taking the Heathrow Express to Paddington and then the Hammersmith & City or Circle Line to Kings Cross/St Pancras.) Trains for Sheffield leave from St Pancras twice an hour (journey time approximately two hours fifteen minutes).

From London Gatwick to Sheffield

Trains run from Gatwick Airport to London St Pancras about three times an hour and take just under an hour. Trains for Sheffield leave from St Pancras twice an hour (journey time approximately two hours fifteen minutes).

From London Stansted to Sheffield

Take the train from London Stansted to Tottenham Hale (four trains an hour, journey time approximately half an hour). Then take the London Underground Victoria Line Southbound to Kings Cross/St Pancras (journey time approximately twenty minutes). Trains for Sheffield leave from St Pancras twice an hour (journey time approximately two hours fifteen minutes).

From East Midlands to Sheffield

Take the half-hourly Skylink bus to Derby Railway Station (journey time approximately half an hour) from where three trains an hour leave for Sheffield (journey time approximately forty minutes).

From Leeds Bradford to Sheffield

Take the half-hourly Flying Tiger bus service 757 to Leeds Station (journey time approximately forty minutes) from where there are two trains an hour to Sheffield (journey time approximately forty minutes).

Getting around Sheffield

Getting around much of Sheffield City Centre is easiest done by tram, which stops at the **Railway Station**. Most hotels are based near **Fitzallen Square Pond's Forge** and the Diamond and St George's Church (the main conference venues) are based near **University**.
